



Moore Norman Technology Center is providing a series of classes to educate, encourage and equip business owners and entrepreneurs who are venturing into e-commerce.

The center is offering a combination of online classes to help individuals learn such topics as creating a website, adding features to begin selling products on the site, digital marketing techniques and online business strategies.

A goal with the series "is to make it as easy as possible for business owners to be able to sell online," said Gina Bertoletti, business development coordinator.

E-commerce is especially a need for businesses now given economic impacts from the COVID-19 pandemic.

A recent survey among businesses participating in the Oklahoma Main Street program – which helps communities improve their historic central and neighborhood business district areas – showed the toll that the pandemic has had so far on businesses and the importance of online sales capabilities.

Brent Kisling, executive director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, said in a news release that the survey spotlighted "the need for all small businesses to have an e-commerce presence in order to better withstand disasters."

The survey also showed that an online presence appeared to play a significant role in the severity of the disruption to businesses. Restaurants and retail with the ability to sell online reported a 49 percent decrease in sales, while those without e-commerce availability showed a 67 percent loss.

Bertoletti said the center wanted to offer a series of classes to meet business owners wherever their need might be to achieve e-commerce, whether it's creating a website or incorporating digital marketing.

Class series focuses on creating e-commerce capabilities for businesses

Meeting more customers virtually

The series includes a free "Build a Website with WordPress" course that gives individuals the chance to create a website using WordPress, a popular website builder. From there, individuals can further those skills through other courses in the series – which are "Advanced Techniques using WooCommerce," which will focus on adding more features and extensions to the website; "E-commerce Quick Start" and "Adventures in E-commerce Digital Marketing."

Each course is \$99 and individuals can receive a 10 percent discount if they sign up for more than one paid class.

Bertoletti said the classes will feature live instruction, and students will have "links to a goldmine of resources to all of these classes."

There also will be a Facebook group for participants to allow for increased interaction and assistance among one another and with their instructors.

Bertoletti said an overall goal is to help individuals set up e-commerce capabilities for their companies that can help them thrive and be better equipped to handle challenging economic situations.

"We're going to do whatever we can to help these businesses," she said.

CLEET - Private Security

CLEET Testing is available at Franklin Road and South Penn Campuses. Ask about evening testing availability.

Private Security Guard Phase 1

Private Security Guard Phase 1 is required for all security guard license applicants. Instruction is provided in writing reports, responding to fire emergencies, first aid applications, and provisions of the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act. This course is designed to prepare you for the State of Oklahoma examination for armed and unarmed private security licensure. Phase I also constitutes partial fulfillment of Private Investigator licensure. Must be at least 18 to start this program.

Private Security Guard Phase 2

Private Security Guard Phase 2 is required for all armed and unarmed security guard license applicants. Instruction is provided in good public relations skills, performing patrol duties, working fixed-post assignments, and investigating security incidents.

Private Security Guard Phase 3

During Phase 3 of the Private Security Guard training, you will learn the basic duties and tasks of private investigators. Topics covered include responsibilities to clients, law of private investigations, Fair Credit Reporting Act, conducting investigations, surveillance, and locating and communicating information.

Private Security Guard Phase 4

Private Security Phase 4 is required for all persons who want to become licensed armed security officers. Instruction will focus on the handling and firing of a handgun. Firearm usage will be conducted at an off-campus firing range under close supervision. You are required to furnish your own .38 through .45 caliber handgun and 400 rounds of ammunition.

Real Estate

Real Estate Sales Provisional, Part I

This course will prepare you for the Real Estate Sales Associate Licensing Examination that is given by the Oklahoma Real Estate Commission. The course provides a basic foundation in real estate and is recommended for anyone associated with the real estate industry. Upon successful completion of this course, you may sit for the state examination, and upon passing the examination, will be issued a provisional sales associate license. This license will be valid for one year, including the month of issuance. The provisional sales licensee is required to complete Part II of the Basic Sales Education Requirement (45 hour post-license course RE400 or RE501) within the 12-month license term and provide proof of completion before license expiration. You will remain a provisional associate for a period of one year.







Preparing peace officers

Cadets say technology center's academy offers extensive training for law enforcement career

Courtney Vandeberg and Darby Hammonds share a goal of wanting to serve and protect people in their communities.

They are learning more about that role, along with extensive training and courses, as cadets in the Basic Peace Officer Certification Academy at Moore Norman Technology Center.

"It feels like we've really gotten the best of the best as far as training goes," said Vandeberg, of Oklahoma City.

The academy, which began last year, is open to adults 21 and older who want to pursue a career in law enforcement, security or corrections.

The program meets the mandated basic peace officer requirements from the state's Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training. In addition, students also receive training in ethics, report writing, legal matters, community and human relations, firearm training, First Aid and CPR, law enforcement driver training and patrol and criminal investigation.

So far, 33 cadets have graduated from the academy, said Jerry McConnell, director of public safety.

The program is 18 weeks and classes are at the center's Franklin Road campus.

McConnell has said the academy offers an avenue for individuals to pursue careers as peace officers and a program that can assist area agencies with hiring and training needs.

There also are plans to continue to expand the program, such as through continuing education and training opportunities and building a driving course on property near the Franklin Road campus. Plans are to start groundwork early next year for the course, McConnell said.

Vandeberg and Hammonds said they are impressed overall with the training offered in the academy and the real-world applications.

"It's a great program," Vandeberg said, adding that instructors have "really went the extra mile" to help educate and prepare cadets.

Hammonds said one area that she's enjoyed learning more about is the firearms training.

"I didn't expect myself to do as well as I have done. It's really boosted a lot of self-confidence," Hammonds said. "It just encourages me to continue to train and get better."

Hammonds, of Oklahoma City, works for the Cleveland County Sheriff's office in the detention center. A future goal is to work patrol in a police department and interact with the community, she said.

Hammonds said she believes the academy is helping to strengthen her knowledge and skills.

"They've gone way above and beyond and poured everything into us and it's been great," she said.

Vandeberg is a police officer in Midwest City and said she decided to pursue law enforcement after working as a paramedic. She got to know police officers through the job and became interested in that career field, along with her "desire to be available to the community and help others."

Tasha Stacy, program developer, said she is fascinated by the caliber of cadets in the academy and the integrity and leadership skills they display.

"The quality of officer is amazing that we're seeing," Stacy said.

Stacy said it's also exciting to be involved in a program that is assisting area agencies by training and sending out "top quality officers."


"This is my passion being able to be a part of this organization," said Stacy, a former police officer. "This cutting-edge environment that I'm working in right now is absolutely amazing."



Asbestos Air Monitoring

Approximately 200 workplace fatalities occur every year, which can be directly attributed to the improper use of a forklift. This course teaches the fundamentals of safe and proper forklift operation and addresses all relevant regulatory requirements. If you are an experienced operator, this course will help you fine tune your operating skills and refresh your understanding of safe operating procedures. This is due to federal law regulation ANSI B56 5.2.4, which states an operator cannot have any body parts outside the operator compartment. To ensure safer operation, a forklift operator must fit within the confines of the equipment. 4 class hrs

MNTC does not issue credentials or endorsements. This class is held at MNTC's CDL track at 600 Research Park Blvd., Norman. 20 class hrs

State Department of Education School Bus Certification with Theory and Behind-the-Wheel Drive Time

Hours consist of classroom and demonstration time to prepare new hires for taking the CDL driving test and obtaining the State Department of Education bus driver certification required to transport students. This class emphasizes safety. Other topics covered will be the walk-around inspection the using bus driver checklist, passenger load/offload, railroad crossings, emergency evacuations, drug testing requirements for licenser, sound driving practices, and how to obtain the Oklahoma State Department of Education School Bus Driver Certificate. Many hours behind-the-wheel driving instruction are included with this class.

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CDL Training at MNTC

Center loads up more classes, training for CDL program

Moore Norman Technology Center is delivering more courses and training opportunities for those interested in a commercial driver's license.

The license is what is required to operate large vehicles, such as those used for municipalities, transportation and construction.

Center officials said the classes and training can help companies in the region with training needs for truck drivers, help local school districts by offering classes for those interested in becoming bus drivers and equip individuals who are pursuing careers in commercial transportation.

The center's program also now features a CDL skills pad, which is a lot area where individuals can practice vehicle inspection and backing skills.

The program also offers opportunities for drivers to take continuing education courses or skills training.

"Education doesn't stop once you receive your CDL. It keeps going," said Jennifer Taylor, instructor/coordinator at the center and a third-party CDL examiner.

"We want to be the go-to place for this educational need," Taylor said.

Taylor said one of the exciting developments for the program is the opening of the CDL skills pad at 600 Research Park Blvd. in Norman. The pad was completed in the fall of 2021.

The pad gives people a place to practice specific skills and also is certified as an exam site for the Department of Public Safety. That certification allows for the pad to be used for skills exams for those testing for their commercial driver's license, Taylor said.

The technology center also is partnering with Central Technology Center for truck driver training classes that will start in February. Participants in the classes also will utilize the skills pad.

In addition, the technology center will be listed on the training provider registry with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. Drivers will be able to choose the technology center to fulfill required training for entry-level drivers of commercial vehicles under a new federal regulation that takes effect in February 2022.

Also starting this spring, the center will offer a motorcycle basic rider course. The Motorcycle Safety Foundation will provide the curriculum for the class that starts in March.

Taylor said the new training and class opportunities can help enhance the knowledge and skill level of commercial drivers, bus drivers and motorcyclists.

She also said she hopes the program can lead to more commercial drivers, especially given the need for more drivers in the trucking industry.

"I see help that's coming for all of these 'help wanted' signs around Oklahoma," she said.

Taylor also said she appreciates the efforts from the center and program partners for working to expand the training and classes offered through the program.

"Together, we will help our community," she said.




