- Please note that only **ONE** requirement in bold block is required (test scores of any age are accepted).
- Your shot records could be part of your high school transcript, we will accept that documentation.
- You **MUST** have 2 Varicella vaccinations (Chickenpox).
- Before getting any additional vaccinations have your TB Skin test given FIRST, otherwise you may see a false positive.
- The only way to increase your score above the other applicants is through the DAT (Abstract Reasoning). You may take this test twice. We will accept the highest score.
- Be sure to sign and submit the Waiver on page 18.

#### Attendance:

- Because this program contains fast track, college level work, your attendance is crucial for this program.
  - Surgical Technology skills can only be demonstrated, learned and perfected with a hands on approach, therefore by missing days you will fall behind quickly.
- Because we have so much material to cover before you begin clinicals, we begin class at 9 am and will work through dismissal time at 4:10 pm. Lunch break is typically 12-1

## Clinical Requirements:

- Our clinical sites do not allow painted or artificial nails, facial piercings and artificial eyelashes.
